




M.V. "SILVERAY" - Electric Cables.

Mr. H.D. Wight of Messrs. The Sunderland Forge & Engine Co. Ltd recently called at this Office and stated his Firm had had experience of the use of ^{Varnisheel} Cambric Cables and had found them satisfactory in all respects.

Mr. Wight further stated that he would point out to the Makers that it was necessary that tests of these cables should be made at the National Physical Laboratory or a similar institution and the results ^{be} submitted to the Committee, in order that it may be decided whether cables of this type may be accepted in lieu of paper insulated cables in future cases.

IT IS SUBMITTED that as these cables appear to be satisfactory and have been fitted with the Owners' consent, they might be accepted in this instance.
