I am in receipt of Mr. Badger's letter of the 17th instant respecting the insulated cables fitted in the Motor ship "SILVERAY" and note that the insulation resistance of these cables is less than that specified in the Rules for rubber insulated cables.

In the circumstances I shall be glad to learn whether there were any special reasons for the use of cables insulated with varnished cambric, and also whether these cables were specified by the Owners of the vessel, and, if not whether their consent to the use of cables of this type was obtained.
