This vessel, so far as now seen, is in efficient condition and eligible in our opinion to remain as classed with record Examined 8.42 (12 mo) and date of drydocking 8.42 subject to stem plate 3rd strake below main sheer (S.S.) E.W. 4.40 being specially examined at next drydocking, to indented plate "C" 2 (S.S.) repaired plate in 1st strake below main sheer in way of Boiler Room Screen Bulkhead (S.S.), indented plate 1st strake below sheer S.S. amidships, repairs to frames brackets etc in fore Peak being dealt with at owners first convenient opportunity. 2 lengths of cable and Bower Anchor to supply.

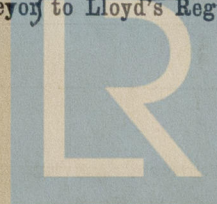
