S. With reference to Mr. Allan's first entry report No. 26323 and report No. 26324 on the new steamer "BELGE", I have to request that he will be good enough to state whether from the date of his last visit on the first entry report it is to be understood that his first entry survey was not complete until then, or whether the first entry survey was complete by the 36th, on which date the vessel sustained the accident by striking the deck entrance when about to proceed on a voyage to Caen.

If the latter is the case the last date of survey for the special survey of the vessel during construction should be given for insertion on the first entry certificate.
