With reference to your classing letter dated the 30th. instant, respecting the steamer "FELICIANA", Messrs. Furness Shipbuilding Co's yard No. 17, I have to state that the duct keel as fitted in the vessel is 154 feet long, between frames 75 and 127, extending through the boiler room, as shewn on the plans as built. There is therefore no centre girder in the boiler space. The top angles of the duct keel sides are .54 in this space as approved and recorded in my report No. 11282.
