With reference to inquiries which have been received from your office in connection with the outstanding surveys on the above named vessels, I may say that some difficulty has been experienced in obtaining definite information regarding the maintenance of their classification with this Society.

However, I have now been able to obtain an official statement from the War Shipping Administration which indicates that these vessels are to retain their class and I attach a copy of the Administration's letter dated the 23rd instant, which will be self-explanatory.

It remains for me to communicate with the operators with a view to ascertaining what arrangements can be made for the requisite surveys to be held and I shall let you know when I have definite information on these matters.
