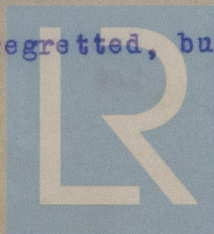
We have to acknowledge receipt of your telegram of the 4th instant regarding the first entry report on the steamer "CLARA" and confirm our reply sent today as per enclosed copy.

In compliance with your request of an explanation for the delay we have to say that the first entry report on the hull was prepared and handed over to the Builders for signature in the middle of December, prior to the ~~most~~ recommendations for class being inserted as customary.

The Builders were twice reminded that the report had not yet been signed and returned, and both times we were informed that the Directors were away in Rome and Vienna, but that immediately on their return the report would be signed and handed back.

Owing to this delay and the intervention of the local holidays the report was only returned signed to this office on the 3rd instant.

The delay is regretted, but under the circumstances was unavoidable.





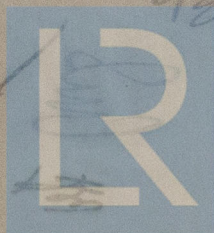
