S.S. "TINHOW"

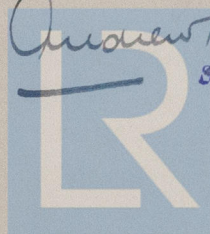
We acknowledge receipt of your letter under date of 12th. inst., advising us that the Special Survey No. 1, as also the Boiler Survey on the above vessel, is now due.
