s.s. "THODE FAGELUND" - Main Boilers.

We beg to acknowledge the receipt of your favour of the 15th inst. regarding the state of the main boilers, together with necessary repairs of the two side boilers enabling the vessel to proceed with 150 lbs. pressure for the time being, and that another survey is to be held before the end of March next, for which we thank you.

In connection herewith we beg to inform you that we have ordered 3 new main boilers from Messrs. North Eastern Marine, Wallsend-on-Tyne, and as these boilers will not be ready for installation before the end of June we hope that the two boilers now in use will prove safe after having been surveyed as recommended, until the end of June or July, when the ship is to be taken over to the Tyne for fitting of the new boilers.
