 A.M. Minesweeper No. 895
 marked as below, has been surveyed during construction by the undersigned.
 Material has been tested by the Surveyors to Lloyd's Register; the scantlings
 in accordance with the Society's Rules for a working pressure of 235 lbs.
 per square inch, and the workmanship is good. The Boiler having been
 in my presence on the 8th September 1919 by hydraulic pressure
 353 lbs. per square inch, showed no signs of weakness, and was
 tight and sound in every respect at that pressure. Working pressure
 exceed two hundred & thirty-five lbs. per square inch.


