Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them a report from the Society's Surveyors at this Port on the machinery of the steamer "TACOMA STAR", from which it appears that, in view of the condition of the repairs which have been carried out to the starboard engine bedplate, and to the starboard engine H.P. valve casing it is recommended that the former should be again examined before the end of October 1942 and the latter before the end of May 1942, and the Committee have accordingly continued the vessel's classification in the Register Book subject to this being done.

I may add that the vessel has been assigned the records KC 11,41 and T.S.10,41.
