I am in receipt of your letter of the 16th instant requesting to be furnished with the report of the survey held at this port on the machinery of the steamer "WANGARATTA" and with regard thereto I have to acquaint you that this vessel has been under the inspection of the Society's Surveyors at this port with a view to classification and that the survey of the machinery has already been carried out with the exception of the examination of the starboard main boiler and the adjustment under steam of the Main and Donkey Boiler Safety Valves. The Society's Surveyors at this port have been informed that the steamer has proceeded to the Bristol Channel to bunker and take in a part cargo and will return to this port on Tuesday next and arrangements have been made to complete the survey on her arrival. ^{here} I shall therefore be glad if you will be guided accordingly.
