

Referring to my letter of 21st inst regarding the No 1 Survey of this vessel I shall be obliged if you will arrange for the Surveyor to proceed with the Survey as soon as possible, the bunkers are ready for his inspection now, and I should like to mention also that there is to be a special survey of some damaged plating on the port after deck house and boat davit socket on Friday next at ^{noon} 11.0 am. when I should be glad if your Surveyor would also be present. This damage occurred while the vessel was leaving Dock in Liverpool last November and the Bersey Dock Co are sending a representative from Liverpool to see the damage and agree as to extent of repairs necessary.

Will you please let me know if you require the midship and deck plans of the steamer as in the case of "Nowshera" and I will endeavour to get them from the Company.
