Dear Sir,

With reference to your call at this Office with Mr. M. Brown, respecting the s.s. "WANGARATTA", built by Messrs. Workman, Clark & Co. Ltd., for which vessel I am pleased to know this Society's classification is desired, I think it well to suggest that perhaps the best course for you to adopt would be to approach the Builders with a view to their furnishing plans of midship section and profile & decks, showing the scantlings and including the pillaring arrangements of the vessel as actually built. If these plans can be obtained and forwarded for consideration I need hardly say that they will receive very careful attention. Of the plans produced by Mr. Brown, the piping plan has been retained in the meantime, and I shall be glad to be supplied with a plan of the boilers and particulars of the diameter of cylinders, length of stroke, diameter of propeller, whether the screw shaft is fitted with a continuous liner or otherwise, and the sizes of the shafting.
