

S.S. "WANGARATTA" - No. 34866

in Register Book.

This vessel is of the "G" standard type and was built in 1919 by Messrs. Workman, Clark & Co., and is classed with the British Corporation.

The Owners, The British India Steam Navigation Co., desire that the vessel should be classed with this Society in view of her having a Lloyd's Refrigerating Machinery Certificate.

Captain W. Isdale and Mr. Brown, representing the Owners, have called at this Office to discuss the matter. It was explained to these gentlemen, it had been found in some previous cases of standard vessels in which the plans had been mutually approved by this Society and the British Corporation that when Owners had subsequently desired the class of such ships to be transferred from the British Corporation to Lloyd's Register, and the scantlings and arrangements had then been investigated, that the British Corporation had departed from the arrangements mutually approved. In view of this it had been decided that in all cases plans of such vessels should be submitted for approval.

It was suggested that the Owners should approach the Builders with a view to the latter supplying plans of midship section, profile and decks shewing the scantlings and including the pillaring arrangements of the vessel as actually built. If these plans are submitted for consideration the same will receive careful attention.

It is further submitted that Captain W. Isdale of The British India Steam Navigation Co. be informed as above as desired.

Of the plans produced by Mr. Brown the piping plan (1 plan) has been retained in the meantime.
