Lithgows Yard No.898/9, and have to acquaint you that the plans of welded bedplate columns and entablature will be approved, provided the whole of the work be carried out to the entire satisfaction of the Surveyors and that after an extended test bed trial all the welds are examined and found to be sound and free from defects.
