E. I duly received your letter of the 16th instant, with enclosures advised therein, respecting Boilers Nos. E.W.109 and E.W.110 to be constructed by Messrs. Barclay, Curle & Co., Ltd. for Messrs. Lithgows' Yard Nos. 898/9, and I have to inform you that the plans of cylindrical and Oil fired & exhaust heat boilers will be approved for a working pressure of 120 lb. per square inch, provided the boilers be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

The Steel Testing Surveyors should be advised regarding the tensile strength of the shell plates and butt straps, viz:- 29-33 tons per square inch.

The plans in question are returned herewith, and I shall be glad if you will arrange for verified copies to be forwarded to this Office for reference purposes.
