

STEAMERS "TREFUSIS" and "TREGONELL".

These two vessels, one being of the Standard "A" Type, and the other of the Standard "B" Type were originally built under the survey of the British Corporation and classed with that Society.

On their being taken over from the Shipping Controller by the Hain Steamship Company the new Owners requested that they be surveyed and classed by this Society, and this has been done.

The "TREFUSIS" was launched 27th July, 1918, the date of build in this Society's Register Book is 1918, and she was surveyed and classed with this Society in November, 1919. The date of build in the British Corporation Register Book is September, 1918.

The "TREGONELL" was launched 28th March, 1918, the date of build in this Society's Register Book is 1918, and she was surveyed and classed with this Society in December 1919. The date of build in the British Corporation Register Book is May 1918.

A letter has been received from the Owners stating that there appears to be some uncertainty as to the date from which the Special Surveys should be reckoned, but they hope that the time will count from the date on which the vessels were classed by this Society.

These vessels began to run within a few months of their being launched, but as their date of build is at present noted as 1918, it is considered that the date on which their subsequent special Surveys become due be counted from the last month of that year.
