Dear Sirs,

I have to inform you that the ~~S.S. "WAR ACONITE"~~ to be re-named "TREPUSIS" has been taken over by Messrs. The Hain Steamship Co., Ltd., from the Ministry of Shipping, and they desire to have her classed with this Society.

It is understood the vessel is about to leave London for your port where she will be placed in dry dock for inspection.

I shall therefore be glad if you will be good enough to give the case the necessary attention when required. The vessel is a standard ship of the "A" type. You should examine the vessel and her machinery and compare the scantlings and arrangements in the ship with those on the plans that have been approved by this Society for this Standard type, and any departures from the approved plans should at once be reported.

On completion of the survey you should forward your report on a first entry report form, stating also the condition of the vessel, for the information of the Committee in dealing with the case.
