Dear Sirs,

I have to inform you that Messrs. The Hain Steamship Co., Ltd., are taking over the S.S. "WAR ACONITE" to be re-named "TREFUSIS" from the Ministry of Shipping and they desire to have her classed with this Society.

The steamer is at present discharging in London and on completion will be placed in dry dock for inspection.

I shall therefore be glad if you will be good enough to give the case the necessary attention when required. The vessel is a standard ship of the "A" type. You should examine the vessel and her machinery and compare the scantlings and arrangements in the ship with those on the plans that have been approved by this Society for this Standard type, and any departures from the approved plans should at once be reported.

On completion of the survey you should forward your report on a first entry report form, stating also the condition of the vessel, for the information of the Committee in dealing with the case.

For your information I enclose herewith a copy of a letter which has today been addressed to the Owners respecting this case.
