

S.S. "WAR ACONITE" to be re-named "TREFUSIS"
STANDARD "A" TYPE

This vessel was built by Messrs. W. Doxford & Sons at Sunderland in 1918 and is classed with the British Corporation.

A letter has been received from the Hain Steamship Co.Ltd., stating that they are taking over this vessel from the Ministry of Shipping and it is desired to have the classification of Lloyd's Register as is common with the rest of their Fleet.

The steamer is at present discharging in London, after which it is said she will be dry docked for inspection.

The Company wish to be informed if this Society's Surveyors will arrange to be present when the boat is in dry dock, also when the machinery is opened up, with a view to the steamer obtaining this Society's classification.

It is submitted the Hain Steamship Co., be informed that if they will be good enough to inform this Office when and where the vessel is in dry dock and also when the machinery is opened up for examination, the Society's Surveyors will be instructed to attend.

The London Surveyors should be advised and requested to give the matter their attention when required. The vessel is a Standard ship of the "A" type. The Surveyors should examine the vessel ^{the machinery} and compare the scantlings and arrangements in the ship with those on the plans that have been approved by this Society for that Standard type, any departures from the approved plans should be reported by them at once to this Office.

On completion of the Survey they should forward their report on a First Entry Form, stating also the condition of the vessel, for the information of the Lloyd's Register Committee in dealing with the case.
