
It has subsequently been learned from the Belfast Surveyors that some repairs are required to the electrical circuits and the Rule spare gear requires to be completed. The Vessel's class has been continued without fresh record of survey subject to the electrical circuits being repaired and the Rule spare gear completed, and a note to this effect is being made on the memorandum in this office regarding the case.
