
With reference to the Secretary's letter of July 27th regarding the S S "FALERNIAN". I beg to acquaint you that the Owners intend to supply new bower anchors to properly stow in the hawse pipes, but as these new anchors cannot be delivered for about 10 weeks, and the vessel is likely to be taken up by the Government, arrangements are now being made with a view of efficiently securing the present anchors in place.

As regards the Water Tight doors, the bunkers are now full of coal and the Owners request that the inspection of same may be deferred until the vessels return - see also Owners letter enclosed.

I shall be glad to be informed if the above proposals are approved by the Committee.
