



The drawing of the tailshaft is considerably overdue and we had made arrangements to carry this out during her lay-up in Liverpool, but unfortunately owing to the dock strike we were unable to obtain tugs and carry this out. We had again made arrangements to do it this voyage during her stay in London, but the Owners find themselves in a very awkward predicament as one of the vessels they had chartered has had a breakdown, and they are anxious to turn the "Vikingstar" round as quick as possible, with a view to her returning to pick up this freight. Under these circumstances we should be glad to know if you would permit us to put off this dry docking until her return from the River Plate, in two months time, as otherwise it would cause great inconvenience and loss.

We ask this favour with diffidence as we quite appreciate that she is considerably overdue at the present time.
