I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 13th instant, enclosing one you have received from the Messageries Maritimes Star Line, requesting <sup>a</sup> the report on the s.s. "EMPIRESTAR".

In taking the matter up with the owners here to-day I am informed that the name of the vessel was misquoted in their letter, and should have referred to their new Steamer "KUSIADA" (Glasgow first entry report No. 39737).
