M. With reference to my letter of the 25th ultimo regarding the proposed classification with this Society of Messrs. Napier & Miller's No. 225, "^dLUAIADA" which vessel has so far been constructed under the supervision of the British Corporation, I am directed to inform you that the question of fees chargeable has received consideration, and that, in the circumstances, it is considered that a total fee of £150 be charged for the survey and classification of hull and machinery, in addition to the usual fee for the survey of Refrigerating Machinery and Insulation.
