

S.S. "LUCIADA"

Napier & Miller's No. 225

Standard "A" Type

This vessel which was launched a few days ago has been built under the survey of the British Corporation.

The Blue Star Line have now taken her over from the Shipping Controller and desire this Society's Classification. The Glasgow Office was informed of this on the 25th ultimo and have replied stating that they have the case in hand.

The ordinary fee for building under Survey and 1st Entry for the Hull would amount approximately to £154, and for the Machinery £49, making a total of £203.

In the Steamers "WAR CHARON" and "WAR HECUBA" of the "G" Standard Type built by Messrs. Workman Clark & Co., and also taken over by the Blue Star Line when in an advanced stage of construction, the ordinary total fees for hull and machinery for each vessel would have amounted to £297, and the Committee approved that a fee of £200 should be charged for the Survey and classification of hull and machinery, in addition to the usual fee for the Survey of Refrigerating Machinery and Insulation.

It is submitted that in the present case a total fee of £150 be charged for the survey and classification of hull and machinery, in addition to the usual fee for the survey of Refrigerating Machinery and Insulation.
