S. I have to acknowledge the receipt of your telegram of today respecting the steamers "ZOUAVE" and "SKELDERGATE" as follows:-


"ZOUAVE SKELDERGATE GLASGOW REPORTS 49905 AND 49991

With regard to the case of the "ZOUAVE", I think it well to point out that the fees on the hull have not yet been received, and in accordance with the usual practice the certificates have been withheld pending payment.

With respect to the "SKELDERGATE", the report on the hull has not yet come to hand from the Leith Surveyors, and in the circumstances I shall be obliged if you will take the matter up with the Surveyors with a view to the issue of the certificates being expedited.
