S. I am in receipt of Mr. Gwynne's letter of the 9th instant with reference to the equipment of the Steamer "MAID OF ATHENS" and carefully note what he says on the subject. With a view, however, to the matter being considered by the Committee, I have to request that you will be good enough to furnish me with an explicit answer to the last two paragraphs on page one of my letter of the 4th instant regarding the size of the cables as actually ascertained at the time of the survey, in view of Mr. Gwynne's statement that the cable "may be taken as full 1 12/32", and he should further state what was the method of measurement adopted.
