I am in receipt of your letter of the 15th instant regarding the above vessels, and have to inform you that the arrangements as approved in your Office for Messrs. Blythwood's Tankers in respect of the bottom longitudinals in way of the pump room are in order.

With regard to the vessels to be built by Messrs. Harland & Wolff, the Surveyors will note that no size is given on the Midship Section for the reverse bars to be fitted to the bottom longitudinals in way of the 13'7" span in the pump room, and they should satisfy themselves that the bottom longitudinals at this span are equivalent to the Rule requirements.

The plan forwarded by you is returned herewith.
