E. I return herewith two copies of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 18th instant, of Riveted Air Receivers proposed for Messrs. J.G. Kincaid & Co's Engines Nos.K.131/2/3/4, Messrs. Elythwood S.B. Co's Yard Nos.61/2/3/4, and I have to inform you that this plan will be approved for a working pressure of 350 lb. per sq. inch, provided the air receivers be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

The Steel Testing Surveyors should be advised regarding the tensile strength of the shell plates and butt straps, viz:- 29-33 tons per sq. inch.
