This vessel was built in 1924 to N.V. classification but has not been classed with this Society.

Plans of the vessel were examined in the Glasgow Office in March last, with a view to recommending the vessel for class 100 A.1 when it was found that certain additions would be required.

The Hartlepool Surveyors now forward particulars of the scantlings together with a report of an examination made.

The vessel has been placed in dry dock and the requirements of a s.s. No.3 for a vessel not built under survey complied with.

The additions to the scantlings and equipment have been fitted.

The materials and workmanship are good. The steel was tested by the Society's Surveyors.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to be classed 100 A.1 (steel) with record of survey 6-25 and notation of s.s. Hpl. No.3-6-25.
