With reference to Hpl Report No. 16312 on the S-S. "CAIRNHILL" ex "NITEDAL" forwarded to-day, it will be observed that no fees for survey have been inserted thereon.

The total fees chargeable for this vessel if built under survey at the present time would be £ 386: 8: 0 made up as follows:-
