Dear Sir,

S. With reference to your letter of the 24th March last respecting an interview which you had with Mr. Blackwood, of Messrs. Macbeth, Blackwood & Laurie, Ltd. respecting the contemplated purchase of the Steamer "NITEDAL", I have to acquaint you that the report on the classification of this vessel (which has now been named "CAIRNHILL") has now been received from the Society's Surveyors at West Hartlepool.

The total fees chargeable for this vessel if she had been built under survey at the present time would have been £386. 6. 0, and the Surveyors propose to charge an inclusive fee of 175 guineas (£183. 15. 0), which is approximately 50% of this amount.

Before giving approval to the fee suggested, I shall be glad if you will kindly let me know whether the fee to be charged for the classification of this vessel was discussed in any way by you with the Owners' representative.
