Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 12th instant forwarding a copy of correspondence sent you by the Society's Glasgow Office regarding the proposed classification of the S.S. "HITDAL", together with eight plans of the vessel which have been considered in the Glasgow Office, and I have also received your letter of the 15th instant reporting as desired upon the scantlings of the hatch webs &c. in way of No.4 hatchway, the contents of which have been noted.

With regard thereto I have to state that the scantlings of the hatch webs above referred to, as now reported by you, will be approved. The plan of hatchways sent for reference with your letter of the 15th instant is returned under separate cover.

The eight plans dealt with in the Society's Glasgow Office are also returned for your guidance in carrying out the survey for classification, and I think it well to explain that, in the case of ships already built, it is not the practice to stamp the plans until the Society's Surveyors have checked the scantlings from the actual ship.
