"NITEDAL" now at this Port with a view to classification we beg to state that the hatch webs at No.4 hatchway have been checked when it was found that the depth of the webs at the centre line was 16½" and the thickness 42" instead of 16" x 40" as shown on the plan of hatchways forwarded by you.

The scantlings of the top and bottom angles were however found to be as shown on the plan.


The plan of hatchways is enclosed herewith which we shall be pleased to have returned at your convenience.
