Dear Sirs,

E. I am in receipt of your letter of the 22nd instant respecting the s.s. "HITDAL", and with regard thereto I have to acquaint you that with steam reciprocating engines having cylinders 25", 40½" and 67" dia. by 45" stroke, working pressure 180 lb. per square inch, propeller 17 ft. dia. and screw shaft fitted with a continuous liner, the sizes of shafting fitted, viz- crank and thrust shafts 13.1/4", intermediate shaft 12.11/16" and screw shaft 14.1/4" dia., will be accepted.

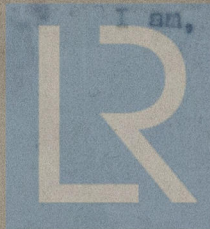
Further, the auxiliary boiler will be accepted for a working pressure of 180 lb. per square inch, provided the same be examined throughout and found in a good and safe working condition and its scantlings be as shown on the plan.
