Dear Sir,

I enclose herewith plans of the main boilers and the pumping arrangements of the S/S "NITEDAL" which is now undergoing survey at this port with a view to classification.

The machinery was built to the Rules and under the Survey of the Nowegian Veritas.

The boiler plan appears to comply with the requirements of the Rules for the pressure of 180lbs. at which the boilers have been working, except the shell plates which I find work out to 177 lbs. at 26 tons tensile strength.

The steel was ordered from Messrs J Spencer & Sons, 12th August 1923 and all delivered before November 1923, order O/1264, and was tested by the Surveyors of this Society.

The plan of the auxiliary boiler <sup>and</sup> the sizes of shafting will be submitted after verification.
