Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 4th instant returning the Classification Certificate of the motorship "JAVA" for alteration as regards the tonnages, I have to say that it is presumed that the alteration in the net tonnage as originally supplied by the Builders is due to the Norwegian interpretation of their tonnage rules for the deduction of erections from the gross tonnage, and that the poop which was at one time deducted from the gross tonnage is now included in the net tonnage.

The Certificate has been amended in accordance with the pencil notes and has been despatched by hand to Messrs. The British Molasses Co., Ltd., as requested.

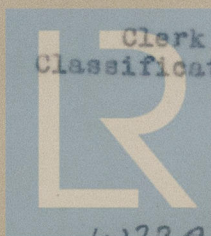
