Dear Sirs,

With reference to your report No.12643 on the Motorship "JAVA", I have to acquaint you that the Agents for the Owners have called at this Office to-day and have stated that the vessel is now outward bound to Abadan and that on her return to the Suez Canal the first entry certificates will be required by the Canal Authorities.

The fees for the survey of the hull do not appear to have yet been paid, although those for the machinery have been received, and I have therefore to request that you will take up the matter promptly with the Builders, as it is the desire of the Owners that the certificates should be on board the vessel on her return to the Suez Canal.

You will be so good as to advise me immediately the fees are paid, and at the same time let me know whether the Builders will be agreeable to the certificates being handed to the Owners' Agents at this port.


