This is to Certify *that I have*

Surveyed the steel single screw steamer "ANTIGONE" of London, 4545 tons gross, whilst afloat at West Saint John, N. B. on 13th April, 1943 and subsequently, after damage stated to have been sustained during heavy weather between 22nd and 27th March, 1943, whilst on a voyage from United Kingdom to Canada, in ballast condition; also damage stated to be due to vessel ranging alongside and bumping wharf at Berth 12, West Saint John, N. B. on 14th April, 1943,

and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that ^{temporary} all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and

that I have Recommended that she be retained as now classed without fresh record of survey, subject to indented shell plating 1st strake below upper deck sheer strake in way of No. 5 hatch (s.s.) being dealt with at first convenient opportunity; also subject, as at present, to repairs to stem, stem plating, and hawse pipe (p.s.) at first opportunity; indented plating, &c. (s.s.f.) and forward bulkhead wing plate being dealt with; repairs to indented sheer strake and deck stringer plating (s.s.) in way of Nos. 1 and 5 hatches, also forecastle side plating, at first convenient opportunity; and indented plating (p.s.) abreast ~~being fit to carry~~ No. 5 hold being dealt with,

being fit to carry dry and perishable cargoes.
