VESSEL'S NAME "BLACKTOFT" REPORT Hul. No. 52728

The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The class is subject to indented plating etc. (p.s.f) and shell plates B.6 & 7, and C.5 & 6 and floors etc. in way (p.s.) being dealt with at the first convenient opportunity, also to (a bower anchor and 15 fathoms of chain cable being supplied).

The HULL Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated and on account of damage sustained whilst on "Operational Service", stem and stem plating, shell plates B.7 and in G & H strakes in way of bunker (s.s.), in E & F strakes (p.s.a), Poop side plating and cantframes (p.s.) found indented. Temporary repairs effected and permanent repairs are recommended at the first opportunity.

A further "General Examination" due 5.44 held and repairs to bunkers, casings, structure in machinery spaces and to minor items effected.

It is submitted the vessel is eligible to remain as classed with record of docking date 1.45, subject as recommended and as above and to have the notation of "Examined 1.45" valid for 12 months assigned.
