Port main air compressor, all cylinders, pistons & valves.
Port and starboard supercharging arrangements.
Port and starboard thrust and intermediate shafts with thrust block and bearings.
Auxiliary air compressor complete.
The two starboard main starting air receivers.
Two starting air receivers for auxiliary (Kromhout) engine.
