Dear Sirs,

E. I enclose herewith an extract from a letter dated 4th instant, addressed to the Manchester Surveyors, respecting independent fusing of alarm circuits for the exhaust turbo-electric propulsion scheme for the s.s. "CITY OF VENICE", and with regard thereto I have to acquaint you I am now advised that Messrs. Workman Clark (1928) Ltd. are supplying the fuses at Belfast and it will therefore not be possible to carry out the proposed tests at Manchester. In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will arrange to carry out the test on board the vessel.

For your information I may say that the fuses to be tested are those shown on Metropolitan Vickers' Plan B.855283 (copy enclosed) connected to the switch KS where marked "Propulsion Machine Control" and they supply the propulsion generator separately excited field and some alarm circuits. It is required that these circuits be connected exactly as shown when making the test outlined in the enclosed letter.
