Under these circumstances we shall be glad to receive your instructions as to the attendance of an electrical Surveyor to witness the tests at Belfast.

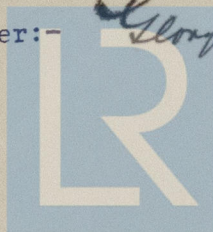
