S.S. "CITY OF VENICE".

We duly received your letter of the 18th instant and in reply to the points raised therein we would advise as follows:-

The common fusing of the alarm circuits and the generator separately excited field has been done deliberately ^{and} by doing so assurance is given that the plant cannot be operated with the alarm circuits "dead".


This arrangement is also in accordance with our standard practice for alarm and similar essential circuits. For such circuits, we use fuses of a sufficient size to ensure that they will only blow in the event of a heavy fault on the circuit in question. In other words, the fuses are not designed to protect the apparatus on such circuits, but the rest of the plant. If light fuses appropriate to the alarm or other such apparatus are used, the liability of failure of the essential circuits so protected is increased.

This practice has been successfully in use for many years and we should much regret having to depart from it. We trust, therefore, that in view of the above reasons for our arrangement we may receive your approval of it in the present case.
