Metropolitan Vickers Electrical Co., Ltd., and with regard thereto I have to say that these plans of arrangement of cables and details of connections of exhaust turbo-electric installation will be approved, provided the installation be as shown and amended on the plans and the remaining requirements of the Rules for Electric Fittings be complied with and the work be carried out to your satisfaction.


I have to add that drain holes should be provided in the trough between the generator and cubicle to prevent the accumulation of condensed moisture.

I return herewith one set of nine plans, the duplicate plans being retained for reference, and have to request that you will forward a complete wiring diagram together with a description of the scheme.
