Précis of particulars of Casualty *Stranded in fog on rocks in Danger Bay, north of Saldanha Bay, on 18th December, 1942. Vessel was firmly wedged and became flooded throughout, being particularly badly holed in No.1 hold and engine room. The engines were set up and shifted. Surveyor last visited the steamer on the 7th June, 1943, when he stated he was satisfied she could not be refloated.*
