The Newcastle Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock and bottom coated.

Alterations have been effected to the thrust recess and tank top, and additional intercostals fitted and floors partly doubled in way of the seating for the Bauer-Wach turbine which has now been installed.

Fractured shell plates G9 on port and starboard sides have been renewed and minor repairs carried out.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 10,30.
