E. I duly received your letter of the 19th instant, with enclosures, respecting Messrs. Barclay, Curle & Co's Yard No.666, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that the diagrammatic plan of Pumping Arrangement in the Machinery Space will be approved, provided the arrangements be as shown thereon and the remaining requirements of Sections 20 and 34 of the Rules (1936-7) be complied with so far as they are applicable.

It is concluded that two independent means will be provided for circulating the main condensers, and that one of the boiler feed pumps will be provided with a connection to the sea, but I shall be glad to learn if these conclusions are correct.
